

Oklahoma Approved Medical Micropigmentation Course



A Career in Permanent Makeup

Permanent makeup is a very exciting and rewarding career. With a career in permanent makeup, you can be your own boss and become an entrepreneur. With a Medical Micropigmentation License, the possibilities for growth are endless as you are not only limited to brows, eyeliner and lips. After mastering these standard procedures, many artists choose to advance into more advanced procedures like areola pigmentation and scar camouflage also known as Paramedical Tattooing

What Will You Learn During Your Course?

Our Oklahoma approved Medical Micropigmentation is a 300-hour course.

This course will be 3-4 months long (this will vary due to time of year and holidays). Classes will be held 2 days per week. During this course you will learn the fundamentals for permanent makeup. The procedures you will learn during this course are ombre eyebrows, lip blushing and eyelash enhancement eyeliner. Babe Ink does not feel microblading is a proper procedure as it is traumatic to the skin and most clients are not good candidates. We will not train students how to microblade and will cover in detail the reasons behind this.

You will be required to perform 18 procedures to graduate and be eligible to take your exam through the State Board. Students are responsible for finding their own models for these procedures. The models will pay a fee of \$150 to Babe Ink to cover the supplies used for their treatment including their aftercare kit.

Oklahoma State Requirements

To work as a Permanent Makeup Artist in Oklahoma, you are required to meet the following criteria.

- ♥ Must be 21 years of age
- Must have a high school diploma or GED
- ♥ No felonies or crimes of moral turpitude
- ♥ You will be required to have an overseeing physician to work as a permanent makeup
 artist/medical micropigmentologist in the state of Oklahoma. You must work from the office at
 which they see their patients. You are responsible for finding your own Overseeing Physician, we
 can not assist with this.
- ♥ Blood borne pathogen certification & CPR certification are required (these can be done online and must be completed by the first day of class).

The state will require proof of these to be sent in with your application upon completion of the course. They will run a background check.

Are There Any Other Requirements?

Becoming a permanent makeup artist may not be the appropriate career choice for you if you have neck, hand or back pain, issues with vision, or an unsteady hand. This career requires dedication, patience, the ability to remain calm under pressure, being able to be sedentary during procedures, and a natural artistic eye. You will be taught the fundamentals you need to succeed; However, it will be up to you to apply them. You will need to market yourself, build your business, practice, and grow as an artist. Beginning your career as a permanent makeup artist may be more challenging to those that are not already in the beauty or aesthetic industry and already have a client base. However, this is not a requirement as there are so many successful artists who began without any industry experience or client base. You are required by Oklahoma law to work out of a physician's office and you are responsible for finding a MD, DO or DDS to work under. You will not be allowed to work until you have this.

Where are the Classes Held?

Classes are held inside the Institute for Beauty, Wellness & Regenerative Medicine. This is where Babe ink is located. We are in Midtown Tulsa, on 19th and Harvard.

How Many Students Will be in the Class?

Our classes will be kept to an intimate class size.



What Is the Cost of This Course?

Enrollment Fee \$3,000
The remaining tuition balance due 2 weeks before the course is \$11,500.00
The total cost of this course is \$14,500.

Financing Options

We do not offer financing. Please reach out to your financial institution to see what options they have.

Are There Any Other Fees Not Included in The Tuition?

- ♥ CPR Certification \$12-\$140
- ♥ Bloodborne Pathogen Certification \$10-\$25
- ♥ OSDH Medical Micropigmentation Application Fee approximately \$500.00 -This will be due after completing your course. You will submit it with your paperwork to the Oklahoma State Department of Health.
- ♥ State Testing Fee approximately \$200.00 -This test will be taken and paid for at a vocational school, in their testing center.
- You may schedule your test after you have been approved by the OSDH to test.
- The model fees will be charged to the models prior to their service. The cost is not charged to the student.
 The model fee covers the procedure items used on them during their treatment.
